Referrals To Behavioral Health Services

The Psychiatric Admissions Department is available 24/7 to provide assessments by trained mental health staff for inpatient placement or can provide a referral for Outpatient services. Direct referrals can be made directly to the Psychiatric Admissions Department by Emergency Departments, County Crisis Agencies, and Case Managers, provided that sufficient clinical information is available. If admission is indicated, the referred patient must be medically cleared and admitted through an Emergency Department.

INPATIENT SERVICES

Adult Inpatient Program

Our adult inpatient programs in Connellsville and Monongahela specialize in the treatment of emotional and behavioral difficulties experienced by individuals 18 years or older. These units operate 24/7 and feature both private and semi-private bedrooms as well as living, dining and recreational areas. Intensive psychotherapies, nursing and educational services aim to re-establish emotional and cognitive stability, enhance self-confidence, instill and reinforce coping capabilities and initiate a plan of post-hospital care to complete and sustain recovery.

Substance Recovery

The CNX Foundation Substance Recovery Unit at Penn Highlands Mon Valley provides withdrawal management and treatment services for people experiencing substance use disorders that need the highest level of care. It is the only unit in a four-county area that provides a continuum of care for people with substance use disorder who have other medical conditions.

The unit includes, a safe and supportive environment; 24-hour access to the hospitalists Emergency Department, Cardiac Care Unit, Behavioral Health Unit, Medical Imaging and Lab; 14 private rooms; seven ligature resistant rooms; two ADA rooms; Group Therapy Rooms, an Activity/ Dining Room; a Quiet Activity Room; Family Interaction Room.
